## RECYCLING...Little Effort...Big Difference



Did you know that recycling done on an everyday basis could actually help our planet Earth? This can begin even at home. Even you can make a difference! The benefits of recycling are many, from reducing the amount of trash we produce to saving energy. Every little step can make a difference! It is all those small steps that add up collectively to make a lasting impact on our environment!

Recycling paper saves trees! A ton of paper made from recycled paper saves 17 trees. Recycling the newspapers read in the United States each morning could save 41,000 trees a day. Junk mail accounts for the use of 1.5 trees per person per year. We could save about 75,000 trees for every 50,000 people who stop their junk mail.

Plastics and packaging materials are a significant part of our everyday lives. When plastics are buried in a landfill, they can last for at least 700 years! So, the next time you use disposable cups, plates or utensils, give a thought to the amount of waste you are adding to the environment. Our convenience today will be at the expense of our future generations!

Recycling is more than just keeping empty plastic bottles and aluminum cans out of the garbage. Recycling is a process that includes collecting a wide range of recyclable materials, processing them into raw materials and then manufacturing the raw materials into new products.

Manufacturing using recycled materials takes significantly less energy than manufacturing using the original raw materials...

- Aluminum from recycled cans saves 95 percent of the energy
- Plastic from recycled bottles saves 70 percent of the energy
- Steel from recycled cans saves 60 percent of the energy
- Newspaper from recycled paper saves 40 percent of the energy
- Glass from recycled jars saves 40 percent of the energy

If we translate energy savings into actual household energy, many hours of energy are gained. A ton of paper manufactured from recycled paper can save about 4,000 kilowatt hours of energy. One glass jar manufactured from recycled glass saves enough energy to power a 100 watt light bulb for four hours. One pound of steel manufactured from recycled steel can power a 60 watt light bulb for over a day. If the amount of aluminum produced in one year was made from entirely of recycled aluminum, enough energy would be saved to power 18 million households for a year. Astounding, isn't it?

If each and every person takes responsibility and practices the concept of recycling; then one can certainly have hope for the future of this planet. The more that individuals and businesses participate in recycling, the more our planet will give to us. Some of the gifts that Mother Earth will bestow upon us are fresh water, clean air, healthy wildlife, litter-free shorelines, and a thriving and abundant plant life. Sounds like a good deal!

## Curbside Recycling Programs in Lebanon County

**Annville Township:** Annville Township contracts its waste and recycling services to Lebanon Farms Disposal. Recycle bins are available at the Township Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, office paper and newspaper. Contact the Township Office at 867-4476 with questions or to report missed collections.

**Cleona Borough:** Residents of Cleona are asked to contact one of the licensed haulers to arrange for waste and recycling services. Acceptable items include: clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact your waste hauler with questions you might have regarding recycling. Contact the Borough Office at 272-7167 with any other questions.

**Cornwall Borough:** Residents of Cornwall are asked to contract recycling services through one of the licensed haulers. Recycle bins are available at the Borough Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact the Borough Office at 274-3436 with any questions.

**Jackson Township:** Residents of Jackson Township must contract recycling services through one of the licensed haulers. Recycle bins are available at the Township Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact the Township Office at 866-4771 with any questions.

**Jonestown Borough:** Residents of Jonestown Borough must contract recycling services through one of the licensed haulers. The Borough provides recycle bins to residents at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact the Borough Office at 861-5414 with any questions.

**Lebanon City:** Residents of the City must contact one of the licensed haulers for waste and recycling services. The City provides recycle bins to residents at no charge. Mandated recyclable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. For more information on Lebanon City's recycling programs, visit [www.lebanonpa.org](http://www.lebanonpa.org) or call the City's Recycling Coordinator at 228-4490 Ext. 2430 with any questions.

**Mount Gretna Borough:** Mount Gretna Borough contracts its waste and recycling services to TNT Sanitation Service, Inc. Recycle bins are available at the Borough Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact the Borough Office at 964-3270 with any questions.

**Myerstown Borough:** Residents of Myerstown must contract waste and recycling services through one of the licensed haulers. Recycle bins are available at the Borough Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact the Borough Office at 866-5038 with any questions.

**North Cornwall Township:** Residents of North Cornwall Township must contract recycling services through one of the licensed haulers. Recycle bins are available at the Township Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact Jean Long at the Township Office at 273-9200 with any questions.

**North Lebanon Township:** North Lebanon Township requires its residents to contract directly with one of the licensed haulers for waste and mandated recycling services. Recycle bins are available at the Township Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, and #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY. Contact Bonnie Grumbine at 273-7132 with any recycling questions or concerns.



**North Londonderry Township:** Township residents may select any licensed hauler for waste and recycling services. Acceptable items include: newspaper, clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, and #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY. Contact Mike Booth at 838-1373 with any questions.

**Palmyra Borough:** Weekly curbside recycling collection services are provided by the Borough. Recycling containers are available at the Borough Office at a cost of \$13. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, newspaper, office paper, cardboard, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, and #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY. Please call the Borough Office at 838-6361 with any questions.

**South Annville Township:** Township residents may select any licensed hauler for waste disposal and recycling services. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Please contact the Township at 867-2846 with any questions.

**South Lebanon Township:** Township residents must contract waste and recycling services with a licensed hauler. Free recycle bins are available at the Township Building. Acceptable items include: clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Contact Phyllis McGann at 274-0481 with any questions.

**South Londonderry Township:** Residents of South Londonderry may select any of the licensed residential haulers. Recycle bins are available at the Township Office at no charge. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Call the Township at 838-5556 with any questions.

**West Cornwall Township:** Township residents may select any licensed hauler for waste and recycling services. Acceptable items include: clear, green, and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum and steel cans, #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY, and newspaper. Call the Township at 272-9841 with questions.

**West Lebanon Township:** The Township contracts waste and recycling services to TNT Sanitation, Inc. Recycle bins are available at the Township at no cost. Acceptable items include: clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel cans, newspaper, and #1 through #7 plastic bottles ONLY. Call the Township at 274-1598 with questions.

# PLASTICS

## Still Confused About

### Does The Shape Of The Plastic Make A Difference?

Lebanon County Recycling Programs accept #1 through #7 Plastic Bottles **ONLY!** Shape matters! Plastics that are not bottle-shaped, or jar shaped, such as margarine tubs or yogurt containers, **ARE NOT RECYCLABLE**. Neither are plastic bags, deli or take-out containers, plastic lids, or rigid plastics.

### What Is A Bottle?

Look for a **NECK** that separates the body of the bottle from where the cap or lid is located; bottles or jars have a mouth or opening that is narrower than the base. Soda bottles, milk jugs, peanut butter jars and detergent containers are all considered bottles. If the opening is the same size or larger than the bottom, i.e., a yogurt or sour cream container, it is **NOT** a bottle and **CAN NOT** be recycled.

### Aren't They The Same Plastic Regardless Of Shape?

Plastics with the same resin code are in the same family of plastics but they have different chemical properties. The manufacturing processes used to create the different shapes results in containers with incompatible properties. Bottles and jugs are made though a process called blow-molding. Other plastic containers, such as margarine tubs, are made through a process called injection-molding. When plastic resins produced by different processes are mixed together, the resulting product is not usable for either application in the future.



### Why Do Plastics Have Recycling Symbols If They Cannot Be Recycled?

The recycling symbol can be found on most all types of plastics but it **DOES NOT** mean that it is recyclable. The recycling symbol with a number is actually a plastic resin code that was implemented in 1988 by the Society of the Plastics Industry (SPI). Although the symbol implies that the item is recyclable, its only purpose is to identify the plastic resin used to make the item. The recycling symbol is not copyrighted or regulated and can be placed on any item – whether it's recyclable or not.

### What Are Rigid Plastics?

Rigid plastics are hard plastics and **ARE NOT RECYCLABLE!** They include the following items:

# The Scoop



## Here's the Scoop on Leaf and Yard Waste

Leaf and yard waste is something every homeowner eventually needs to dispose of. But, did you know that it can be recycled...NATURALLY! By throwing it away with the normal trash we are sending it to a landfill where it is using up unnecessary landfill space meant for trash that cannot be recycled. Leaf and yard waste can be recycled into compost which can be used over and over again as food for the earth. Leaves, grass clippings, branches and garden wastes can be composted into a rich soil additive called humus which naturally fertilizes the soil.

This newsletter will hopefully provide you with valuable information when you are raking those leaves and cleaning up the yard. Inside you will find information on municipal leaf and yard waste collection programs that exist in Lebanon County. If your Township or Borough **is not** listed in this newsletter, then it **does not** have a program for leaf or yard waste. If your municipality does not have a program, we have provided information below on how to dispose of your leaf and yard waste for a small fee. Just Remember...**COMPOST**... It's Recycled, **NATURALLY!**

## Where to Dispose of Leaf and Yard Waste?

### Leaf and Yard Waste Disposal at GLRA

Any resident or business of Lebanon County may dispose of leaf and yard waste at GLRA's Compost Facility located at 1610 Russell Road, Lebanon. The cost to dispose of leaf and yard waste is **\$10** for up to **660 pounds** or **\$30/ton**. A GLRA license is required. A tarp is required.

**Annville Township**

**Leaf Collection and Yard Waste Drop-Off**

Annville Township provides a curbside leaf collection program for its residents weekly from October to December. NO BAGS, PLEASE! Leaves will not be picked up if placed in bags! Annville Township sends out a municipal newsletter to its residents with a leaf collection schedule and information on leaf collection procedures. FROM APRIL THROUGH NOVEMBER a dumpster for yard waste is available at the Public Works Department at 675 West Main Street. The dumpster is for RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS ONLY. Hours to drop off yard waste are: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; Wednesday 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; Saturday 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.; and ONE SATURDAY PER MONTH 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m (Sep 17, Oct 15, Nov 12). Contact Annville Township Office at 867-4476 with any questions.

**Cleona Borough**  
**Leaf Collection**

Cleona Borough arranges for leaf collection for its residents. For details on leaf collection, residents are asked to check the website [www.cleonaborough.org](http://www.cleonaborough.org) or contact the Borough Office by phone at 272-7167. Residents may also drop yard waste at North Cornwall Township's Yard Waste Compost Facility after obtaining an address verification form from the Cleona Borough Office.

**Cornwall Borough**  
**Leaf Collection**

Cornwall Borough provides curbside leaf collection for its residents beginning in October and ending in December. The Borough Highway Department will pick up leaves in all areas except ones zoned Residential Forest. Residents can obtain the leaf collection schedule online at [www.cornwall-pa.com](http://www.cornwall-pa.com). The Borough also offers a Christmas tree drop-off in a designated area at the Highway Garage from January 1 to mid February. Trees ten feet or more must be cut in half and be cleaned of ALL decorations! Christmas tree bags WILL NOT be accepted. Contact the Borough Office at 274-3436 with questions.

**Jonestown Borough**

**Leaf, Limb and Christmas Tree Collection**

Jonestown Borough collects tree limbs, 4 inches in diameter and cut no more than 5 feet in length, on a weekly basis. In the Fall, the Borough provides weekly leaf collection. Residents must use CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS. Christmas trees are collected after the holidays. A newsletter is distributed to Borough residents with leaf, limb and Christmas tree collection information. Public notices are printed in local newspapers. Contact the Borough Office at 861-5414 with questions.

**Jonestown Borough**

**Yard Waste Compost Facility**

Jonestown Borough operates a municipal yard waste compost facility for Jonestown Borough residents and businesses ONLY. For any questions or additional information, contact the Borough Office at 861-5414.

**Lebanon City**

**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

Lebanon City provides a Fall curbside leaf collection program annually for its residents. Lebanon City also provides a green waste collection program two times per year in the Spring and in the Fall. The City publishes announcements in local newspapers with this information for City residents as well as on WLBR 1270AM Radio. The City's website will post collection schedules prior to collection events on [www.lebanonpa.org](http://www.lebanonpa.org). For additional questions on Lebanon City's programs, please call the City's Recycling Coordinator at 228-4490 Ext 2430.

**Lebanon City**

**Yard Waste Compost Facility**

Lebanon City operates a municipal yard waste compost facility for City residents and businesses ONLY. There is a \$20 annual fee for residents and a \$250 annual fee for businesses for a key card to access the facility. The key card allows a resident unlimited access to the facility within the scheduled hours. Spring/Summer Hours are Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Fall/Winter Hours are Monday through Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. For a key card application and a list of rules and regulations for the facility, contact Lebanon City Department of Public Works at 228-4490.

**Mount Gretna Borough**

**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

Mount Gretna Borough has a seasonal leaf and yard waste collection program. Leaves and brush are collected two times a year---in the Spring and in the Fall. The Borough sends a letter to all its residents providing the details of the seasonal collection. For more information on Mount Gretna's leaf and yard waste collection program, please contact the Borough Office at 964-3270.

**Myerstown Borough**

**Leaf , Yard Waste and Christmas Tree Collection**

Myerstown Borough provides a leaf collection program for its residents. The Borough collects leaves curbside weekly from October to December. Leaves must be placed CURBSIDE in CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS. Leaves will not be picked up if not placed in clear plastic bags! Christmas trees are also collected after the holidays through mid January. Trees must be placed CURBSIDE. No trees will be



collected from the rear of any properties. Myerstown Borough also provides a Spring yard waste cleanup from mid April until mid May. Yard waste consists of leaves and small sticks. Yard waste must be placed CURBSIDE in CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS no earlier than 7:00 a.m. on pick up day. Can't find clear bags? Clear plastic bags are available at the Borough Office for \$.25 each. Public notices for all of these programs are printed in local newspapers for Borough residents. Contact the Myerstown Borough Office at 866-5038 with any questions.

**North Cornwall Township**  
**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

North Cornwall Township provides a leaf collection program from the end of October to early December. Yard waste (which includes garden waste, shrubbery clippings, tree trimmings and woody yard waste) is collected two times a year during the FIRST two full weeks of April and October. Detailed handouts are available at the Township Office and on the Township's website [www.nctown.org](http://www.nctown.org). Contact the Township Office at 273-9200 with any questions.

**North Cornwall Township**  
**Yard Waste Drop-Off Facility**

North Cornwall Township operates a municipal yard waste drop-off facility for North Cornwall Township, Cleona Borough and South Lebanon Township residents ONLY. Residents of Cleona Borough and South Lebanon Township must first complete a residency verification form with their respective municipal office. Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Friday 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All incoming loads must be secured. Residents must check in at the front office prior to unloading. For questions or any additional information, contact North Cornwall Township Office at 273-9200.

**North Lebanon Township**  
**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

North Lebanon Township collects leaves curbside from mid October to December. Yard waste is also collected a day in April and a day in October. North Lebanon Township will publish dates, times and collection instructions in the Township's quarterly newsletter and also on its website. For additional information, contact the Township Office at 273-7132 or visit the Township's website at [www.twp.northlebanon.pa.us](http://www.twp.northlebanon.pa.us).

**North Lebanon Township**  
**Yard Waste Compost Facility**

North Lebanon Township operates a municipal yard waste compost facility for North Lebanon Township residents

ONLY. There is a \$30 annual fee, renewable every January 1, for a key card to access the facility. This allows a resident unlimited access to the facility and mulch within the scheduled hours. Spring/Summer hours are Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Fall/Winter hours are Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Loading and delivery services are available for a fee. All incoming and outgoing loads must be tarped. For a key card application and a list of rules/regulations for the facility, contact the Township Office at 273-7132 or visit their website at [www.twp.northlebanon.pa.us](http://www.twp.northlebanon.pa.us).

**North Londonderry Township**  
**Leaf Collection and Curbside Chipping**

North Londonderry Township provides weekly curbside leaf collection to North Londonderry Township residents on most public roads from mid October to the first week in December. North Londonderry Township also provides a monthly yard waste chipping program for its residents. On the 1st Monday of each month (except November and December) brush and branches are collected and chipped curbside on most public roads in the Township. The Township also provides an additional collection of Christmas trees in January. Residents will receive a municipal newsletter in the mail from the Township Office with the collection schedule and procedures. Contact North Londonderry's Township Office at 838-1373 with any questions.

**North Londonderry Township**  
**Yard Waste Compost Facility**

North Londonderry Township operates a municipal yard waste compost facility for North Londonderry Township residents ONLY (commercial businesses and nonresidents are prohibited). The Township charges a \$25 annual fee for residents to use the drop-off center. Hours of access to the facility are: April through October; Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Sunday 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and November through March, Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Residents must stop by the Township Office to purchase an annual permit, which includes an electronic access card. Contact the Township Office at 838-1373 with any questions.

**Palmyra Borough**  
**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

Palmyra Borough provides curbside leaf and yard waste collection for all residents and commercial/industrial businesses contracting the Borough's refuse services. Spring leaf collection is offered for one week in March and one week in April. Fall leaf collection is conducted weekly from mid October to mid December. Yard waste and wood waste is collected



the last week of each month (weather permitting during the winter months). Christmas trees and evergreens are collected the entire month of January on the regularly scheduled refuse collection day. Collection schedule information is available online at Palmyra Borough's website at [www.palmyraborough.org](http://www.palmyraborough.org) and also in the Borough newsletter mailed with the quarterly sewer and refuse bills. Contact the Borough Office at 838-6361 with questions.

**Richland Borough**  
**Leaf Collection**

Richland Borough provides a curbside leaf collection program for Richland Borough residents each year. The Borough collects leaves twice a week beginning in October and ending about the third week of November. Contact the Borough Office at 866-5601 with questions.

**South Lebanon Township**  
**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**

South Lebanon Township collects leaves and yard waste curbside from residents twice a year. One combined leaf and yard waste collection is conducted in late April. Fall leaf collection runs from mid October to the end of November with no set days for any area. Yard waste is collected curbside once in the Fall prior to leaf collection. Dates for the yard waste collections will be published in the March and September newsletters. Residents may also drop yard waste at North Cornwall Township's Yard Waste Compost Facility after obtaining an address verification form from the South Lebanon Township Municipal Building. Contact the Township Office at 274-0481 or through e-mail at [sltownship@comcast.net](mailto:sltownship@comcast.net) for more information.

**South Londonderry Township**  
**Leaf and Yard Waste Collection**  
**Feasibility Study**

South Londonderry Township has completed a feasibility study on leaf and yard waste collection in South Londonderry Township. Based on recommendations in the study, the Township is currently looking at a compost facility with drop-off collections for its residents. **West Cornwall Township**  
**Leaf Collection**

West Cornwall Township provides a leaf collection program for approximately six weeks in the Fall and for two weeks in early Spring. Notices are printed in local newspapers for Township residents. For additional information, please contact the West Cornwall Township Office at 272-9841.

**West Lebanon Township**  
**Yard Waste Compost Facility**

West Lebanon Township operates a municipal yard waste compost facility for West Lebanon Township residents and businesses **ONLY**. There is a \$20 annual fee for residents and a \$100 annual fee for businesses for a key card to access the facility. The key card allows Township residents and businesses unlimited access to the yard waste compost facility within the scheduled hours. Hours of operation for the yard waste compost facility are Monday through Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. All incoming loads must be tarped. These are items that you cannot put out with the regular trash, pour down a drain, or dump into the ground out in the backyard. Lebanon County residents may arrange for a home pick-up of household hazardous waste for **ONLY a \$15 Co-Pay!**

When you have your Household Hazardous Waste collected, you may also dispose of your unwanted computers, monitors, TV's, and printers for the same \$15 co-pay. There is a limit of up to 3 complete computer systems (CPU, monitor, printer, keyboard, mouse) and/or TV's plus other electronic equipment such as scanners, tabletop photocopiers, fax machines, VCRs, CD players, DVD players, and stereos.

If you are an elderly and/or disabled resident and unable to gather the household hazardous waste materials for yourself, the contracted household hazardous waste collector, WM Curbside, LLC, will come into your home and do the work for you! Just make sure to let them know your limitations when calling to schedule your pick-up! **Please note that the assistance is available for packing household hazardous waste materials ONLY—NOT for electronics.**
